Knowing yourself, God, and others

1. Open ended questions

- -"What", "How come", How"
- -Allow for responses more than a "yes" or "no"

2. Empathy

- -Empathy is feeling someone else's pain (Not sympathy)
- -Crucial for identifying with people
- -Body language

3. Reflecting meaning/feeling

- -Mirroring what person said
- -Express what they felt
- -Express meaningful things they said

4. Paraphrasing

- -Pulling several parts together
- -Making the content concise
- -Key words, feelings, thoughts, events

- -When people are answering, think about what skill would be best to use in responding to the person
- -Each person will ask a question
- -Group interaction

- -Only through loneliness can you become completely dependent on God

-What am I risking when placing my worth in God?


-What are the benefits of placing my worth in God?
